A scholar and diplomat with more than two decades of experience in Soviet and Middle East policy, Ambassador Ross played a leading role in shaping U.S. involvement in the Middle East process and in dealing directly with the parties involved. He is credited with successfully brokering the Hebron Accord in 1997, the 1994 Israel-Jordan peace treaty and has worked extensively to bring Israel and Syria together. Ambassador Ross also played a key role in the integration of Germany into NATO.

He has served under two presidents and received the highest medal of honor from the State Department.
